Purpose	<p>This grant program is designed to support activities of GSID students and alumni that meet the GSID Alumni Association principles.</p> <p>* Article 2 (Purpose) of the GSID Alumni Association Regulations.</p> <p>The Association is concerned with the following purposes:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Promotion of mutual friendship and exchange among its members</li> <li>2. Contribution to the progress of GSID</li> <li>3. Promotion of international development studies</li> </ol>
2. Activities covered by the grant	<p>All activities covered by the grant must be accomplished within one year from the day of the application's approval.</p> <p>(1) Research activity support: a characteristic research work carried out by GSID students or alumni, which requires support.</p> <p>(2) Social activity support: social contribution activities conducted by GSID students or alumni, which requires support.</p> <p>(3) Other kinds of support: projects which do not belong to either (1) or (2), but meet the GSID Alumni Association's philosophy.</p> <p>Amount of grant shall not exceed 150,000 yen per project (application).</p>
3. Qualifications	<p>Must be a student of GSID (enrolled as Master’s student or PhD student) or GSID alumni.</p>
4. How to apply	<p>Fill out the application form using the designated format and send it to the GSID Alumni Association Secretariat via e-mail by attaching the completed form.</p>
5. Application deadline	<p>October 5th, 2015</p>
6. Submit to	<p>GSID Alumni Association Secretariat (alumni@gsid.nagoya-u.ac.jp)</p>
7. Selection method	<p>Application forms will be screened by the GSID Alumni Association Secretariat. In the case of research activity grant, the opinion of GSID professors and associate professors will be taken into account. The result will be announced on the Home Coming Day, October 17, 2015</p>
8. Period	<p>The awarded plan must be accomplished within one year. A final result presentation (15 minutes) is required to be made in GSID Alumni Annual Meeting to be held in October, 2016.</p>
9. Others	<p>A report of the activity using the report format must be submitted promptly after completion of the project. All printed materials issued in relation to the project must indicate that the project has been supported by the GSID Alumni Association.</p>
