

Scholarships by JASSO
Student Exchange Support Program Scholarship
for Short-term Study in Japan (FY 2013)

JASSO(Japan Student Services Organization) offers scholarship for qualified international students who are accepted by a Japanese university, graduate school, junior college, college of technology(3rd grade or upper) or Professional training college(hereinafter referred to as “Japanese school(s)”)under a student exchange agreement or other student exchange arrangement on a short-term basis from 8days to one year between Japanese school and their home higher educational institution outside Japan(hereinafter referred to as “attending school(s)”).

Qualifications and contents of scholarship (FY 2013)

I. Qualifications and conditions

- i) Students enrolled in a regular course of study in a higher educational institution outside Japan.
- ii) Students accepted by Japanese schools under a student exchange agreement or other student exchange arrangement with their attending school.
- iii) Students who have the ability to earn credits of the course provided by the accepted Japanese school.
- iv) Students demonstrating excellent academic* and personal records at their attending school.

*Applicants must have a minimum GPA of 2.30 from the last two years on the evaluation scale described below and are expected to keep the GPA of 2.30 during the period of grant of the MEXT scholarship.

[GPA Formula]:

$$\frac{([No. of GP3 credits] \times 3) + ([No. of GP2 Credits] \times 2) + ([No. of GP1 Credits] \times 1) + ([No. of GP0 Credits] \times 0)}{\text{Total number of registered credits}}$$

*No. = Number / *GP = Grade Point

Note:

- a) If applicants have taken courses that are not part of the credit system, replace the number of credits in the GPA formula with the number of courses taken.
- b) Grades of “Pass” or/and “Accreditation” which have no grade points are not included into GPA calculation.
- c) When calculating GPA, truncate a number to two decimal places. Ex., 2.654 will be 2.65.

- v) Students not having the financial means to study in Japan.
- vi) Students, upon termination of the period of study in Japan, will complete their studies at their attending school.
